The ALLARM protocol has been developed for citizen projects with the goal of monitoring small streams and their watersheds for **early detection** of the impacts from Marcellus Shale gas extraction in PA. This is a chance for you to make a commitment to **team with neighbors to do something positive** to protect our local water resources.



The Workshop training will cover:

- Marcellus Shale gas extraction
- Finding and mapping permitted gas wells
- Water monitoring site location determination
- Visual assessment monitoring
- Chemical and surrogate flow monitoring
- Community Team Data management and reporting

ALLARM training support is funded through the Consortium for Scientific Assistance for Watersheds (C-SAW) through PADEP Growing Greener.
